There are many ways to switch to manual focus (including using the AF dial or the Super Control panel,) but my favorite method is to use the Manual Focus (MF) Clutch which is a feature on many Olympus lenses. For bird photography, I usually use the M.Zuiko 40-150mm F2.8 PRO or the M.Zuiko 300mm F4.0 IS PRO.

But often, it's simply easier and faster to switch to manual focusing. For best results, follow these manual-focusing steps: Adjust the viewfinder to your eyesight. Set the focus switch on the lens to M. This step assumes that you're using a lens like the Nikon DSLR kit lens. Select a focus point.

Manual focusing will avoid this completely and allow you to get things just right - focusing upon the subject behind that glass or fence. If you do this in conjunction with a large aperture (which decreases depth of field) and get in close to the fence or glass you might well eliminate it completely from being noticeable in your shot.

In the field of photography, a manual focus camera is one in which the user has to adjust the focus of the lens by hand. Before the advent of autofocus, all cameras had manually adjusted focusing; thus, the term is a retronym. The focus itself may be adjusted in a variety of ways.
