Symptoms of ADHD tend to be first noticed at an early age, and may become more noticeable when a child's circumstances change, such as when they start school. Most cases are diagnosed in children between the ages of 6 and 12. Childhood ADHD is more commonly recognised & diagnosed in boys than girls.
